## 2010-2011 Season

### Spring Team

The Spring Development session will be a sampling of what the Fall/Winter season will consist of focusing primarily on Skill Development and Teamwork. Also having an affiliation with the AAA club we will have some shared practices both on and off the ice to maximize the exposure and opportunity for the players.

Specifics will include:

On-Ice Development (2-90 min sessions per week through Memorial Day weekend)

Off-Ice Sessions at Power Shot Hockey Academy Tournaments (1 of the following):

- BD's Suburban Series at the ONYX (Apr 22-25)
- Trenton Spring Invitational, Trenton MI (May 7-9)
- Plus Home and Home Exhibition Games (Approximately 6-8)



*Power Shot Hockey Academy will help with off-ice shooting/stick-work*

Being first year Pee Wee there will be an obvious emphasis on all phases of checking including the Body Check. The Spring session will run from the conclusion of tryouts

through the end of May. I believe in giving the kids the option to have time away from the rink so nothing is planned for June and July so that they can enjoy their summer.

We will develop each of the players based on their individual needs and develop the team with high intensity activities while fostering leadership, teamwork that is supportive, rewarding, and competitive.

## 2010-2011 Season

### Summer Program

Kids play more than hockey and it is anticipated that during this period of time many kids will play baseball, soccer or just take time off. If time and budgets permit we encourage players to attend a power skating camp locally or a summer hockey camp. Any on ice sessions should be informal 3-on-3 format inviting more casual but competitive play.

Those who sign commitments for the Fall/Winter team will also officially register with the Canton Victory Honda's Association. The Association fee is \$155 for a Canton resident and \$175 for non-residents and covers the following:

Home and Away jerseys and socks, league ref fees, all LCAHL registration fees and 1st round LCAHL District fees.

### Fall/Winter Team

The Fall/Winter session will kick off in full swing in August. A mini-boot camp will be held over a selected weekend where the kids will do many off-ice activities together - the focus will be on learning more about each other and developing team chemistry.

The Fall/Winter Development Program will include:

On-Ice Development (3 per week)

Off-Ice Sessions at Power Shot

Tournaments (4): We will look for 2 local tournaments and 2 Canadian tournaments

Goalie Coach (1 on-ice session per week)

We will focus a considerable amount of time on sponsorships to keep the ice and tourna-
